**Raleigh/Durham:** A new 94-suite AmerisSuites opened in Morrisville, a quarter-mile from Raleigh/Durham International Airport. Guestrooms include high-speed Internet access; refrigerator, microwave and coffeemaker; iron and ironing board; satellite television; and two 2-line speaker phones with voice mail. Typical rates are \$79 for a room with a small kitchen area to \$109 for a two-bedroom suite. Rates include breakfast buffet and evening manager's reception. **San Francisco:** The boutique Hotel Juliana, atop Nob Hill and two blocks from Union Square, has a \$149 one-night City Choice Package that includes deluxe accommodations and your choice of complimentary parking or a one-day bus and cable car pass per guest. The package also includes continental breakfast, evening wine reception, newspaper and use of the hotel's fitness studio. For an additional \$30, upgrade to a suite. **Santa Fe:** The Old Santa Fe Inn, a new 43-guestroom and suites property, is five blocks southwest of Santa Fe Plaza and in easy walking distance to Loretto Chapel, the San Miguel Mission (the oldest church in the United States) and the Palace of the Governors (the oldest governmental building in the United States). Most rooms feature a kiva-style fireplace, and many have a private balcony or patio area. The guestrooms have furniture handmade by local craftsmen, and fabrics and rugs patterned from the Museum of New Mexico's collection of textiles. Local artist Willard Clark's woodcuts decorate the walls. Suites offer separate living areas, jetted tubs, microwaves and refrigerators. The rack rate is typically \$149 per night. **Sausalito:** Casa Madrona has been a landmark hotel for almost a century. The hotel has re-opened with a 31-guestroom and

43-ton spa tubs has 11 outdoor hot tubs. The new 31-guestroom and suites expansion and a new spa. The Casa Madrona Mansion was built in 1885 as a private home. In 1910, the property became the Casa Madrona Hotel. After a long and colorful history the property was restored in 1976 to its original elegance with major renovations and the addition of 16 hillside cottages with fireplaces and private decks. The new wing of 31 contemporary-styled guestrooms and suites features sunken Jacuzzi tubs and private balconies overlooking the waterfront. In addition, the hotel has upgraded its original 34 guestrooms with new beds, linens, carpeting, furniture and amenities. Guestrooms in the original Victorian mansion also include turn-of-the-century antiques. The new Avanyu Spa by RockResorts is a day spa that uses Phytomer products and features a manicure/pedicure room, facial room, five massage rooms and a wet treatment room. The hotel also includes Mikayla Restaurant. A Bed & Breakfast package is \$199 through December 31. Other packages are available. (415-332-0502, [www.casamadrona.com](http://www.casamadrona.com))

**Washington:** WestCoast Hotels re-flagged the University Inn at Salmon Creek in Vancouver. The 89-room property, now the Red Lion Inn at Salmon Creek, offers a heated indoor pool, fitness center, business center, guest laundry and complimentary breakfast buffet. Rates start at \$79. **Vermont:** Through early October, foliage

viewing becomes the focus of Vermont travel. Experience the foliage and mountain scenery with a ride on the Killington Skyeship. The high-speed, eight-passenger lift features a variety of cabin designs as colorful as the autumn leaves. This year, Killington offers packages that include rides, dining and regional events. The K1 Gondola lets you enjoy views of five states and Canada from atop Killington Mountain. Both gondolas (K1 and the Skyeship) will run daily throughout foliage season. Guests can mountain bike or hike on a 45-mile trail network, play golf or mini-golf, ride two alpine slides, take on the climbing wall and skateboard or in-line skate in the park. Sometimes the season also brings an early snowfall. Killington's 18-hole golf course is open for play daily throughout the foliage season. Stay and Play packages start at \$96 per person, including 18 holes of golf, cart rental and one lodging night. A two-night minimum stay is required. Other packages include two- to seven-day Fall Foliage bookings from \$47 per person, per day, including lodging and a ride on the K1 Gondola. Fall Foliage Peep, Eat and Ride (two-night minimum) starts at \$65 per person and includes one roundtrip K1 Gondola ride and dinner at an area restaurant. Vermont Cuisine Sampler (two-night minimum) starts at \$56 and includes dinner at a fine dining restaurant.
